

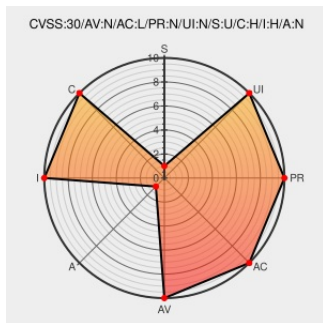

Certain versions of **Wg-c10** from **Sony** contain the following vulnerability:

WG-C10 v3.0.79 and earlier allows an attacker to bypass access restrictions to obtain or alter information stored in the external storage connected to the product via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2017-2277 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
