

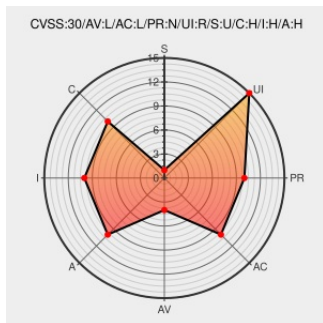

Certain versions of [Tween](#) from [Kiri](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Untrusted search path vulnerability in Tween Ver1.6.6.0 and earlier allows an attacker to gain privileges via a Trojan horse DLL in an unspecified directory.

CVE-2017-2279 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
