Description	The ConvertToPDF plugin in Foxit Reader before 8.2 and PhantomPDF before 8.2 on Windows, when the gflags app is enabled, allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via a crafted PDF file, as demonstrated by a proof of concept exploit.
