

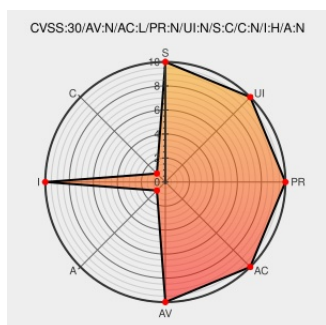

Certain versions of [Traffic Server](#) from [Apache](#) contain the following vulnerability:

There is a vulnerability in Apache Traffic Server (ATS) 6.2.0 and prior and 7.0.0 and prior with the Host header and line folding. This can have issues when interacting with upstream proxies and the wrong host being used.

CVE-2017-5660 has been assigned by [security@apache.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
