Certain versions of **Bbs** from **Synchro** contain the following vulnerability:

Synchronet BBS 3.16c for Windows allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (service crash) via a long string in the HTTP Referer header.

CVE-2017-6371 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
