

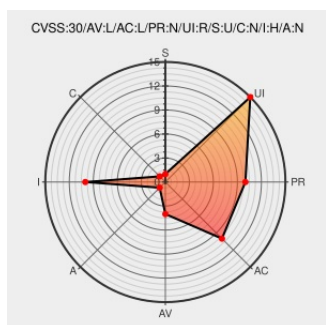

In all Android releases from CAF using the Linux kernel, a KGSL ioctl was not validating all of its parameters.
