

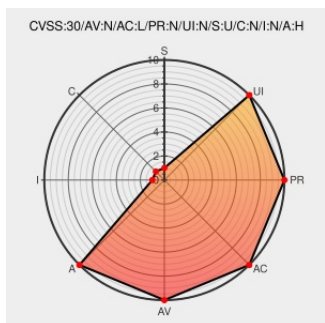

Certain versions of [Mxview](#) from [Moxa](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Moxa MXView 2.8 allows remote attackers to cause a Denial of Service by sending overly long junk payload for the MXView client login credentials.

CVE-2017-7456 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
