

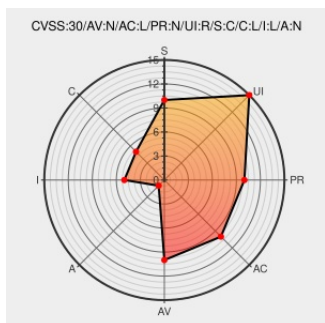

Certain versions of [Mobile Application Platform](#) from [Redhat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

It was found that the App Studio component of RHMAP 4.4 executes javascript provided by a user. An attacker could use this flaw to execute a stored XSS attack on an application administrator using App Studio.

CVE-2017-7554 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
