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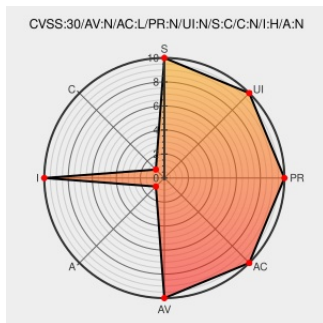

Certain versions of [Vbulletin](#) from [Vbulletin](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In vBulletin before 5.3.0, remote attackers can bypass the CVE-2016-6483 patch and conduct SSRF attacks by leveraging the behavior of the PHP `parse_url` function, aka VBV-17037.

CVE-2017-7569 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
