Certain versions of [Openmrs Module Reporting](#) from [Openmrs](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Reporting Module 1.12.0 for OpenMRS allows CSRF attacks with resultant XSS, in which administrative authentication is hijacked to insert JavaScript into a name field in `webapp/reports/manageReports.jsp`.

CVE-2017-7990 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
