Certain versions of [Gespape](#) from [Gespape](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in Gespape before 7.4.9 allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the (1) printer name when adding a printer in the admin panel or (2) username parameter to `webapp/users/user_reg.jsp`.

CVE-2017-7998 has been assigned by [M](#) `cve@mitre.org` to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
