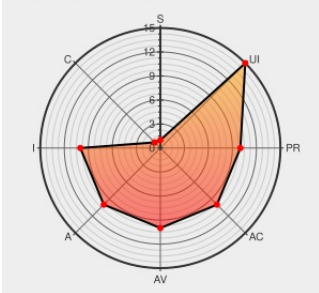

Certain versions of [Whizz](#) from [Browserweb Inc](#) contain the following vulnerability:

There is CSRF in the WHIZZ plugin before 1.1.1 for WordPress, allowing attackers to delete any WordPress users and change the plugin's status via a GET request.

CVE-2017-8099 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
