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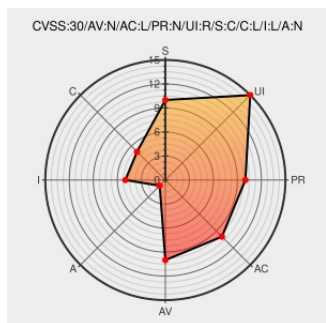

An issue was discovered on Accellion FTA devices before FTA_9_12_180. `courier/1000@/oauth/playground/callback.html` allows XSS with a crafted URI.
