



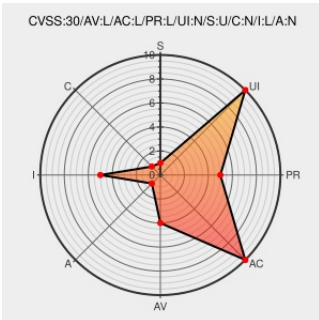

Certain versions of [Rubocop](#) from [Rubocop Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

RuboCop 0.48.1 and earlier does not use /tmp in safe way, allowing local users to exploit this to tamper with cache files belonging to other users.
