

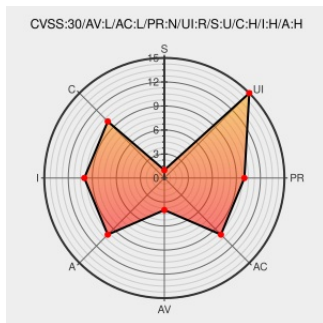

Certain versions of [Logview Pro](#) from [Halliburton](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in Halliburton LogView Pro 10.0.1 allows attackers to cause a denial of service or possibly have unspecified other impact via a crafted .tif file.

CVE-2017-8926 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
