

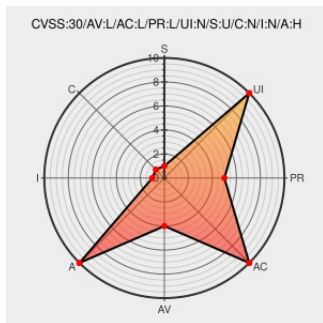

Certain versions of [Pcmanfm](#) from [Pcmanfm Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

PCManFM 1.2.5 insecurely uses /tmp for a socket file, allowing a local user to cause a denial of service (application unavailability).

CVE-2017-8934 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
