

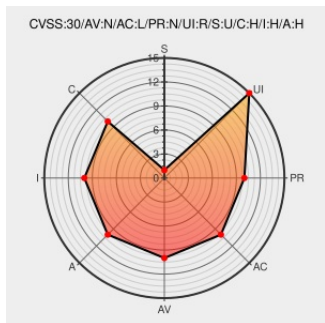

Certain versions of [Openexr](#) from [Openexr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In OpenEXR 2.2.0, an invalid write of size 8 in the storeSSE function in ImfOptimizedPixelReading.h could cause the application to crash or execute arbitrary code.

CVE-2017-9111 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
