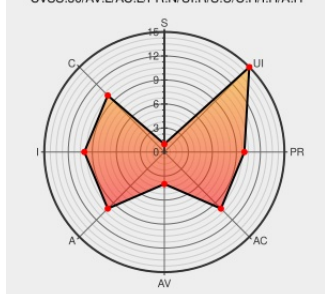

Certain versions of [Obs-service-source Validator](#) from [Opensuse](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A shell command injection in the obs-service-source_validator before 0.7 could be used to execute code as the packager when checking RPM SPEC files with specific macro constructs.

CVE-2017-9274 has been assigned by **ot** security@microfocus.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
