Certain versions of [Facetag](#) from [Facetag Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ws.php in the Facetag extension 0.0.3 for Piwigo allows SQL injection via the imageld parameter in a facetag.changeTag or facetag.listTags action.

CVE-2017-9426 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
