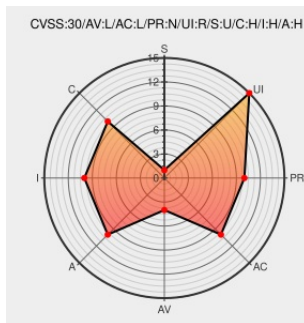

Certain versions of [Xnview](#) from [Xnview](#) contain the following vulnerability:

XnView Classic for Windows Version 2.40 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service or possibly have unspecified other impact via a crafted .fpx file, related to "Data from Faulting Address controls Branch Selection starting at ntdll\_77df0000!RtlpLowFragHeapFree+0x000000000000001f."

CVE-2017-9904 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
