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Certain versions of [Windows](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In SWFTools 2013-04-09-1007 on Windows, png2swf allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service via a crafted file, related to a "User Mode Write AV starting at image00000000_00400000+0x0000000000001b72a."

CVE-2017-9924 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
