Certain versions of [Squert](#) from [Securityonion](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Security Onion Solutions Squert version 1.1.1 through 1.6.7 contains a SQL Injection vulnerability in `.inc/callback.php` that can result in execution of SQL commands. This attack appear to be exploitable via Web request to `.inc/callback.php` with the payload in the sensors parameter, used in `ec()`. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed

in 1.7.0.

CVE-2018-1000044 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
