

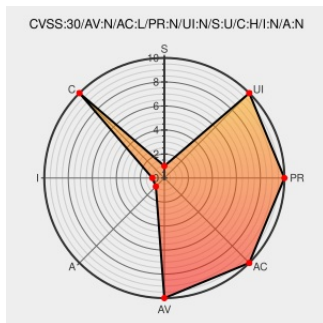

Certain versions of [Iredmail](#) from [Iredmail](#) contain the following vulnerability:

iRedMail version prior to commit f04b8ef contains a Insecure Permissions vulnerability in Roundcube Webmail that can result in Exfiltrate a user's password protected secret GPG key file and other important configuration files.. This attack appear to be exploitable via network connectivity. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed in

Beta: 0.9.8-BETA1, Stable: 0.9.7.
