

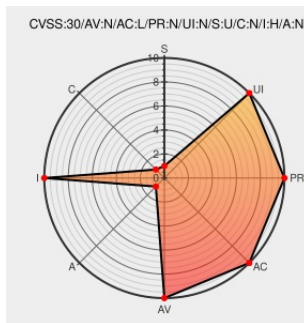

Certain versions of [Lightsaml](#) from [Lightsaml](#) contain the following vulnerability:

LightSAML version prior to 1.3.5 contains a Incorrect Access Control vulnerability in signature validation in readers in `src/LightSaml/Model/XmIDSig/` that can result in impersonation of any user from Identity Provider. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed in 1.3.5 and later.

CVE-2018-1000165 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
