

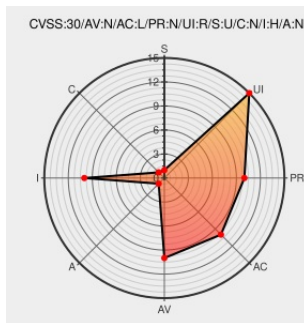

Certain versions of [Tooltipy](#) from [Tooltipy](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Tooltipy (tooltips for WP) version 5 contains a Cross site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Settings page that can result in could allow anybody to duplicate posts. This attack appear to be exploitable via Admin must follow a link. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed in 5.1.

CVE-2018-1000505 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
