

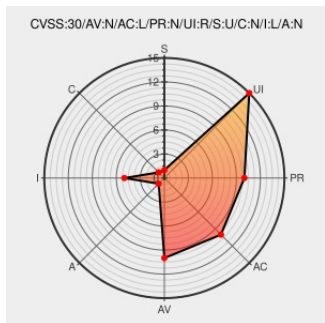

Certain versions of [Limesurvey](#) from [Limesurvey](#) contain the following vulnerability:

LimeSurvey version 3.0.0-beta.3+17110 contains a Cross site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Boxes that can result in CSRF admins to delete boxes. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed in 3.6.x.

CVE-2018-1000514 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
