

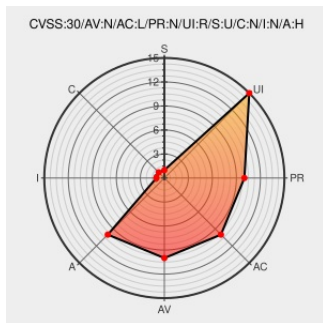

Certain versions of [Jsish](#) from [Jsish](#) contain the following vulnerability:

jsish version 2.4.70 2.047 contains a CWE-125: Out-of-bounds Read vulnerability in function jsi\_ObjArrayLookup (jsiObj.c:274) that can result in Crash due to segmentation fault. This attack appear to be exploitable via The victim must execute crafted javascript code. This vulnerability appears to have been fixed in 2.4.71.

CVE-2018-1000668 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
