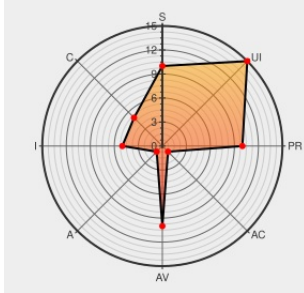

Certain versions of [Phpipam](#) from [Phpipam](#) contain the following vulnerability:

phpipam version 1.3.2 and earlier contains a Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability in The value of the phpipamredirect cookie is copied into an HTML tag on the login page encapsulated in single quotes. Editing the value of the cookie to r5zkh'><script>alert(1)</script>quqtl exploits an XSS vulnerability. that can result in Arbitrary code executes

in victims browser.. This attack appear to be exploitable via Needs to be chained with another exploit that allows an attacker to set or modify a cookie for the phpIPAM instance's domain..

CVE-2018-1000860 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
