

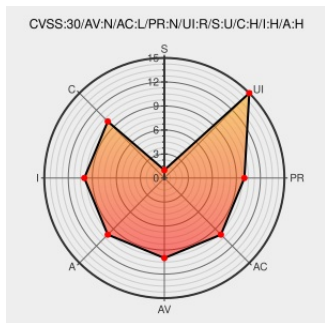

Certain versions of [Cms Made Simple](#) from [Cmsmadesimple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CMS Made Simple (aka CMSMS) 2.2.7 has CSRF in admin/siteprefs.php.

CVE-2018-10030 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
