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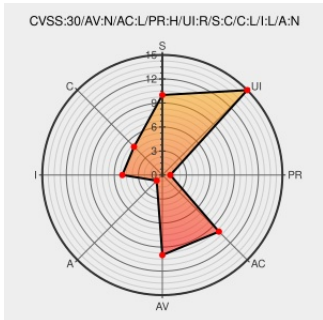

Certain versions of [Joyplus-cms](#) from [Joyplus-cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

joyplus-cms 1.6.0 has XSS via the device\_name parameter in a manager/admin\_ajax.php?action=save flag=add request.

CVE-2018-10096 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
