

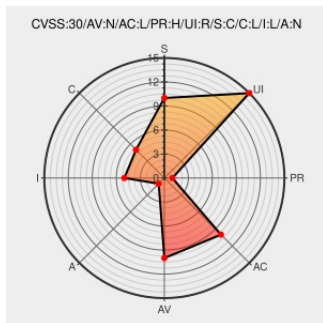

Certain versions of [Monstra](#) from [Monstra](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Monstra CMS 3.0.4 has Stored XSS via the Name field on the Create New Page screen under the admin/index.php?id=pages URI, related to plugins/box/pages/pages.admin.php.

CVE-2018-10118 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
