

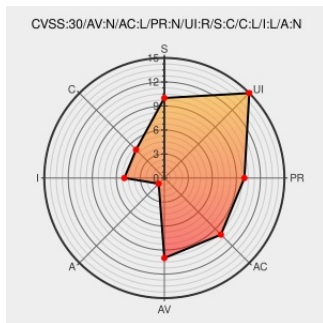

An issue was discovered in XYHCMS 3.5. It has XSS via the test parameter to index.php.
