

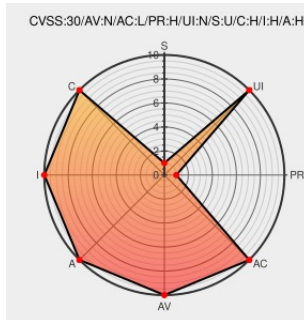

Certain versions of [Poscms](#) from [Poscms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

POSCMS 3.2.10 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via the `diy\module\member\controllers\admin\Setting.php` 'index' function because an attacker can control the value of `$cache['setting']` [`ucssocfg`] in `diy\module\member\models\Member_model.php` and write this code into the `api/ucssocfg/config.php` file.

CVE-2018-10235 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
