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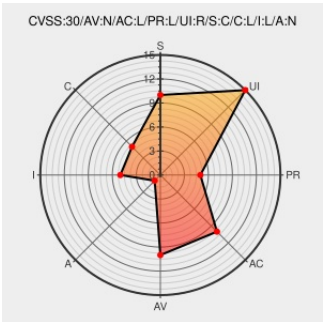

The Responsive Cookie Consent plugin before 1.8 for WordPress mishandles number fields, leading to XSS.
