

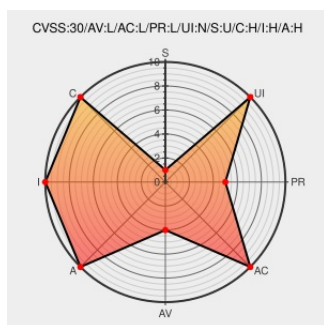

Certain versions of [Galaxy Apps](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

This vulnerability allows local attackers to escalate privileges on vulnerable installations of Samsung Galaxy Apps Fixed in version 4.2.18.2. An attacker must first obtain the ability to execute low-privileged code on the target system in order to exploit this vulnerability.

The specific flaw exists within the handling of a staging mode. The issue lies in the ability to change the configuration based on the presence of a file in an user-controlled location. An attacker can leverage this vulnerability to escalate privileges to resources normally protected from the application. Was ZDI-CAN-5359.

CVE-2018-10502 has been assigned by zdi-disclosures@trendmicro.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
