Certain versions of [Cms Made Simple](#) from [Cmsmadesimple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In CMS Made Simple (CMSMS) through 2.2.7, the "module import" operation in the admin dashboard contains a remote code execution vulnerability, exploitable by an admin user, because an XML Package can contain base64-encoded PHP code in a data element.

CVE-2018-10517 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
