

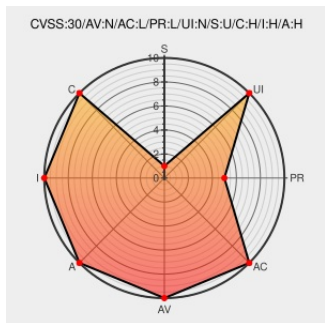

Certain versions of [Cms Made Simple](#) from [Cmsmadesimple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CMS Made Simple (CMSMS) 2.2.7 contains a privilege escalation vulnerability from ordinary user to admin user by arranging for the `eff_uid` value within `$_COOKIE[$this->_loginkey]` to equal 1, because files in the `tmp/` directory are accessible through HTTP requests.

NOTE: this vulnerability exists because of an incorrect fix for CVE-

2018-10084.

CVE-2018-10519 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
