

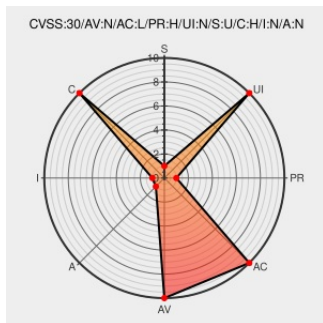


# CVE-2018-10522

Certain versions of [Cms Made Simple](#) from [Cmsmadesimple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In CMS Made Simple (CMSMS) through 2.2.7, the "file view" operation in the admin dashboard contains a sensitive information disclosure vulnerability, exploitable by ordinary users, because the product exposes unrestricted access to the PHP `file_get_contents` function.

CVE-2018-10522 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **4.9 - MEDIUM**
