Certain versions of [EasyCMS](#) from [EasyCMS Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

EasyCMS 1.3 is prone to Stored XSS when posting an article; four fields are affected: title, keyword, abstract, and content, as demonstrated by the `/admin/index/index.html#listarticle` URI.

CVE-2018-10527 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
