Certain versions of [Liferay Portal](#) from [Liferay](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** DISPUTED **** Liferay 6.2.x and before has an FCKeditor configuration that allows an attacker to upload or transfer files of dangerous types that can be automatically processed within the product's environment via a browser/liferay/browser.html?Type= or html/js/editor/fckeditor/editor/filemanager/browser/liferay/browser.html

URI. NOTE: the vendor disputes this issue because file upload is an expected feature, subject to Role Based Access Control checks where only authenticated users with proper permissions can upload files.

CVE-2018-10795 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
