

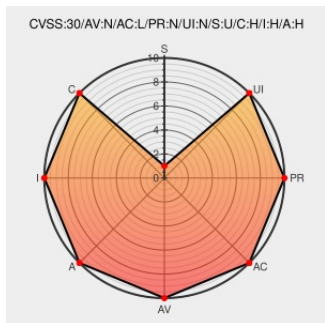

Certain versions of [Etereweb](#) from [Etere](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Etere EtereWeb before 28.1.20 has a pre-authentication blind SQL injection in the POST parameters txUserName and txPassword.

CVE-2018-10997 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
