

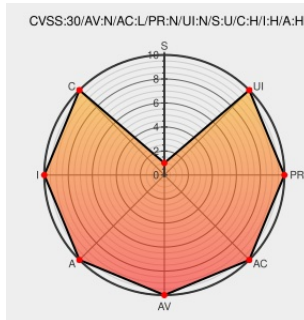

Certain versions of [Ncloud 300](#) from [Intelbras](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered on Intelbras NCloud 300 1.0 devices. `/cgi-bin/ExportSettings.sh`, `/goform/updateWPS`, `/goform/RebootSystem`, and `/goform/vpnBasicSettings` do not require authentication. For example, when an HTTP POST request is made to `/cgi-bin/ExportSettings.sh`, the username, password, and other details are

retrieved.

CVE-2018-11094 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
