Certain versions of [Slac](#) from [Sitemakin](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in SITEMAKIN SLAC (Site Login and Access Control) v1.0. The parameter "my_item_search" in users.php is exploitable using SQL injection.

CVE-2018-11535 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
