

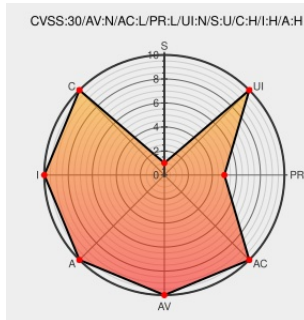

Certain versions of [Samsung Members](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

This vulnerability allows remote attackers to escalate privileges on vulnerable installations of Samsung Members Fixed in version 2.4.25. An attacker must first obtain the ability to execute low-privileged code on the target system in order to exploit this vulnerability. The specific flaw exists within the handling of Intents. The issue lies in the ability to

send an Intent that would not otherwise be reachable. An attacker can leverage this vulnerability to escalate privileges to resources normally protected from the application. Was ZDI-CAN-5361.

CVE-2018-11614 has been assigned by zdi-disclosures@trendmicro.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
