

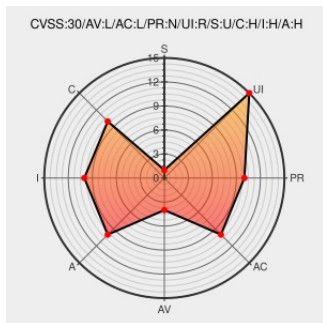

Certain versions of [Radare2](#) from [Radare](#) contain the following vulnerability:

There is a heap out of bounds read in radare2 2.6.0 in `java_switch_op()` in `libr/anal/p/anal_java.c` via a crafted Java binary file.

CVE-2018-12321 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
