

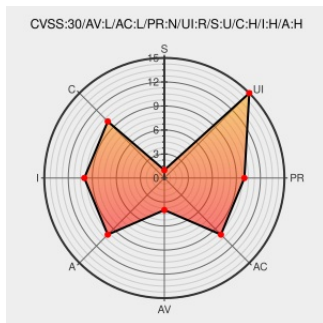

Certain versions of [Polaris Office 2017](#) from [Polarisoffice](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Polaris Office 2017 8.1 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a Trojan horse puiframeworkproresenu.dll file in the current working directory.

CVE-2018-12589 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
