

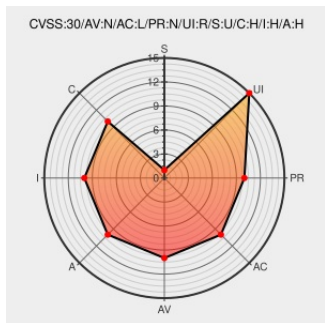

A CSRF vulnerability exists in LFCMS 3.7.0: users can be added arbitrarily.

CVE-2018-12602 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
