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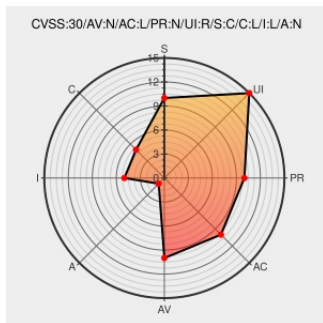

Certain versions of [Adrenalin](#) from [Myadrenalin](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A Reflected Cross Site Scripting (XSS) Vulnerability was discovered in Adrenalin 5.4 HRMS Software. The user supplied input containing JavaScript is echoed back in JavaScript code in an HTML response via the LeaveEmployeeSearch.aspx prntFrmName or prntDDLContrlName parameter.

CVE-2018-12652 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
