

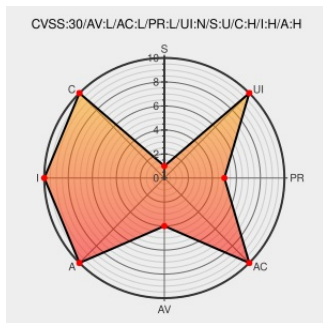

Certain versions of [Crucible](#) from [Atlassian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Microsoft Windows Installer for Atlassian Fisheye and Crucible before version 4.6.1 allows local attackers to escalate privileges because of weak permissions on the installation directory.

CVE-2018-13399 has been assigned by [security@atlassian.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
