

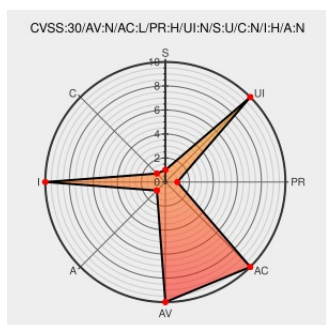

Certain versions of [Jirafeau](#) from [Jirafeau](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A CSRF issue was discovered in Jirafeau before 3.4.1. The "delete file" feature on the admin panel is not protected against automated requests and could be abused.

CVE-2018-13407 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
